Course Description

Building consciousness, knowledge and skills in any endeavor begins with learning the foundational principles. This course is designed to be one of the first courses a students may take when embarking upon a Unity learning journey. Students will explore foundational principles from *Lessons in Truth*, *Discover the Power* and other texts. They will also learn how to integrate the foundational principles into daily life.

Course Learning Objectives

Upon completion of the course, students will have had a cursory introduction to some of the foundational teachings of Unity and will be able to:

- Understand what consciousness is, as well the four functions and four levels of consciousness
- Identify, reflect upon and explain the reasons for humankind's state of bondage.
- Describe the nature of God (principle and personal)
- Describe the three-fold nature of humankind
- Articulate and define Unity Meditation and Affirmative Prayer
- Engage with the teachings of Jesus as reported in the Gospels
